**WHAT TO DO NOW:** It's too early to plant yet, but it's not too early to begin garden planning. Choose your vegetable & flower seeds for spring. Seeds can be started inside & set out in the garden once the weather warms up.

### **PROTECTING YOUR**

**PLANTS:** Low & freezing temperatures are a concern to plant health. We sell N-Sulate & Harvest Guard, two excellent permeable materials for covering & protecting tender plants. Both products are re-usable.

Do not forget to keep plants watered. Well-hydrated plants are less susceptible to frost than dehydrated ones.

**PLANTING:** Perk up your late winter garden with early-blooming plants. White Iberis, lovely Cinerarias, bright yellow Gelsemium, & fragrant Pink Jasmine are great choices, & the latter two are deer resistant. Camellias are still in bloom, &



buds are forming on the Pieris, Sarcococca, & the evergreen Viburnum (davidii & tinus). Remember, for your non deer-resistant choices, we carry
